2023 data covers standing order donations given between 28th December2022 and 20th December 2023.

2023 totals are approximations only and obtained from monies paid in at the moment as access to Gift Aid records is not available. However, a rough approximation based on on possible Gift Aid recovery indicates that £5000 might be expected.

Donations for Bell repairs totals £800 some of which may be eligible for Gift Aid.
